

Rotary Abingdon Riverside Charity Building Bake-Off

Please read the guidelines carefully and ensure your entry meets with the requirements and that you understand how your work may be displayed during the event and in any media and marketing.

Guidelines for entry

- All cakes should have a building theme.
- All skills and techniques and level of ability are welcomed and encouraged.
- Entries should be the original work of the entrant(s).
- Cupcakes can be part of the decorative element of the overall entry.
- Anything used within your entry must be food grade and approved for use with cake.
- Internal supports are permitted but must be entirely covered.
- Style and covering is the competitor's choice – royal icing, sugar paste, chocolate ganache or other edible coating.

To enter

- You will be required to submit the following as part of your entry:
 - Entry Fee £5 individual or £10 team entry.
 - Brief summary of building(s) or structure that inspired your cake bake.
 - List of edibles / ingredients and non-edibles such as supports (if used).
 - Contact details (email/phone number).
- Cakes should be dropped off at: West Waddy ADP, The Malthouse, 60 East St. Helen Street, Abingdon, Oxfordshire, OX14 5EB on Friday 29th September between 8am and 10am.
- Viewing, judging and selling of cakes will be from 11-1pm.
- Winners will be announced at 3pm.
- Please indicate if you'd like to collect your cake(s) – or if you're happy to

donate them to the Rotary Abingdon Riverside Club who will sell them to help raise money for MacMillan.

- If you have chosen to collect your cake(s) please do so between 5-5.30 pm on 29th September.

Judging

- Cakes will be judge on overall theme and design.
- Abingdon Riverside Rotary Club are appointing three judges.
- Three prizes will be awarded, an overall winner, runner-up and highly commended.
- Results will be final and not open to discussion.

Publication of competition entries

- Photographs and details of any entries may be used across website, social media, related email newsletters, and other related marketing material for the Rotary Abingdon Riverside Club or WWADP.
- Photographs and details of any entries may be used for marketing. Details of sponsors and judges to follow.

Display of exhibits

- While reasonable care will be taken with all entries, WWADP cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred during transportation or at the event.
